

1953-1956 Singles Paint Scheme

This petrol tank paneling was taken off an original 1956 petrol tank after the hammer tone silver grey the bike was painted in was removed and under that paint the areas originally protected by the panels stood out as the areas without rust pitting.

The side panels were originally copied on an A4 sheet so if you print the panel picture on an A4 sheet you should be pretty near the original. Since the tank sides are curved a fold was made to compensate which shows in the drawings.

The centre panel was too big to put on an A4 sheet so at the time (1980 or thereabouts) I put dimensions on the drawing.

The kneegrrips are our part# **K12/282**, Oil Bath transfer **NM17731**.
